Activities and Accomplishments

This past year MedMark in Washington, PA saw a decline in growth. We ended our year with 259 patients enrolled in our program. We continue to operate methadone at our program.

Washington's program is accredited by CARF.

This year we began to offer additional supportive services such as group counseling. Additionally, we have partnered with local social service agencies such as the "Center of Excellence" to provide our patients with case management services; as well as continuing to partner with "Central Outreach" to provide testing, treatment and education to our patients on HIV/Hepatitis.

We began working with Sonara in 2024 in the development of a program to help patients become eligible for take home bottles through the utilization of an online dosing window. The Sonara program will be launching in March of 2025, both staff and patients are eager for the program to begin.
